Unlike a natural floor, **DAKKS** wooden flooring needs relatively less maintenance to keep it looking as good as new.

To ensure it always looks its best and last longer, here are some steps you can take to take care of it...



# How often to clean **DAKKS** floors?

The best way to keep your flooring clean is simply to stay on top of it. You should clean your floor thrice every two weeks. If shoes are allowed indoors or if you have pets, you will need to clean more often. Keeping a floor mat at every entrance to your home can help control the excess dirt.

To clean wood floors naturally, especially when they are really dirty, try using baking soda. Baking soda mixed with water is a mildly abrasive, eco-friendly cleaner, which can be applied with a soft cloth or sponge. Mix a solution of one tablespoon baking soda per one cup of warm water and stir before using.

## **After Installation**



- To keep your DAKKS floors fresh, you can mop them every day. Damp mops (a.k.a. microfiber mops) are gentle enough to use on wooden floors.
- Use a damp cloth to blot up spills as soon as they happen. Never allow liquids to stand on your floor for a long period of time.
- Sweep, dust or vacuum the floor regularly with the hard floor attachment (not the beater bar) to prevent accumulation of dirt.
- Entry mats will help collect the dirt, sand, grit and other substances such as oil, asphalt or driveway sealer that might otherwise be tracked onto your floor.
- When replacing your furniture, lift rather than drag, and place back down with care. Add furniture pads for extra protection.

# Here's what to avoid using on your **DAKKS** floors



Following the above tips will help keep your flooring looking great for years. Routine maintenance will help you avoid damage to your laminate flooring. When it comes to taking care of the flooring, you should avoid using oil, polish, wax, shine enhancers, detergents and varnish. Also, never use spray mops, power cleaners, or steam cleaners, as they can damage the flooring.
